AROUND THE CENTRE

Until Government advice changes, we will reduce the capacity of The Kepplewray Centre to 40 persons. This will allow sufficient space in bedrooms and public rooms to maintain a safe distance. Meals are taken over two sittings and a one-way system of moving around the Centre is in place. Extra hand washing stations are in place around the Centre, with signage to encourage our guests to use them. Care will be taken when allocating rooms to ensure a safe distance is maintained. All bedding and rooms will continue to be cleaned between bookings with bedding sent to an external laundry.
