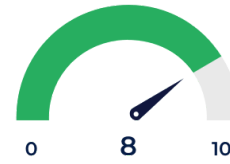

Global Needs Intensity Score



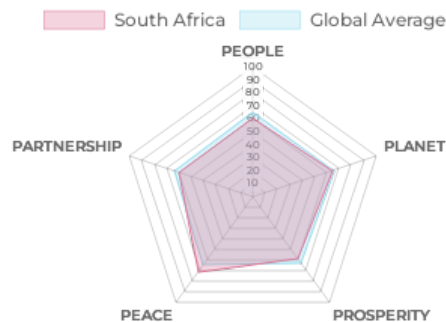
