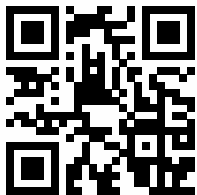

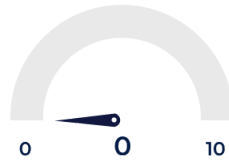

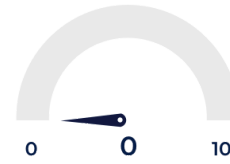

Global Needs Intensity Score



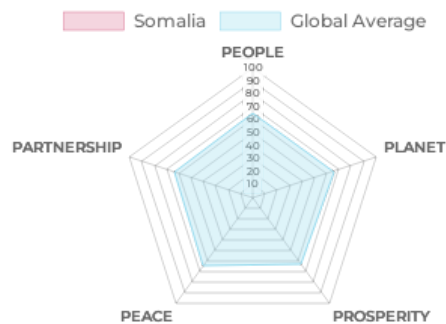
