Global Needs Intensity Score



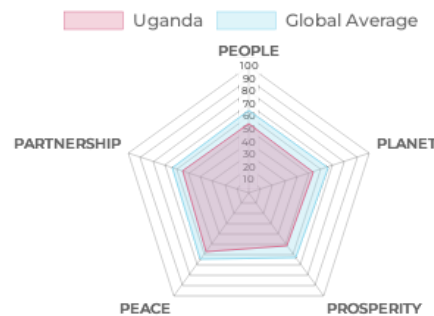
